On the occasion of the IANPHI (International Association of National Public Health Institutes) members' assembly and Brazil's presidency of the G20, which will take place in September 2024, and in order to strengthen and establish institutional ties between Spain and Brazil, the Institute of Health Carlos III (ISCIII), the main public research body in health science and biomedicine in Spain, will be organizing matchmaking sessions **at the Instituto Cervantes, in Rio de Janeiro, on September 12th.**
